

Statewide Collaboration (Who)

The Colorado Medical Home Effort is led by statewide agencies, professional provider organizations, nonprofit organizations, and patient and family advocates.

- The CAFP represents family physicians and supports the concept of physician led teams within the patient centered medical home model.
- The CAFP supports the drive to provide every Coloradoan with a continuous, comprehensive relationship with a patient-centered medical home.
- CAFP supports NCQA PCMH recognition as a proven model to improve quality of care and reduce health care costs.

Systems Change Effort (Action)

Through this statewide medical home collaboration, the CAFP strives to create systems change through *policy development, reimbursement reform, consumer and provider education, and medical practice transformation.*

- The CAFP analyzes, proposes, amends and lobbies for health care legislation.
- The CAFP provides educational activities related to the development of the PCMH.
- The CAFP works with other agencies to support practice transformation activities.

Coordination of Services (What)

The medical home approach supports comprehensive, continuous relationships that coordinate all health services in a quality, cost-effective, and accessible manner.

- The CAFP is working with other medical and health care providers to create an effective medical neighborhood that will value well coordinated medical services, timely and complete transfer of information and respect for patient's informed and shared decision making.
