



ACLS Description:

The Advanced Cardiac Life Support is designed for those in need of American Heart Association (AHA) ACLS. The participant completes the AHA online ACLS Heartcode Part I located at www.onlineaha.org and then attends the 1 hour skill verification on April 12th. The written exam is administered online and the participant prints the certificate of completion at the skill session. AHA ACLS card awarded after skill component is completed.

BLS Description:

Basic Life Support (Basic Life Support) course designed for those in need of American Heart Association (AHA) BLS certification. The participant completes the AHA online Heart Code BLS program at www.onlineaha.org and performs the 1 hour skill verification on April 20th. Skill verification includes adult one and two rescuer CPR, use of an AED and infant CPR. The written exam is administered online and the participant prints the certificate of completion for the skill session. AHA BLS card awarded after online program and skill component has been completed.

PALS Description:

The Pediatric Advanced Life Support is designed for those in need of American Heart Association (AHA) PALS. The participant completes the AHA online PALS Heartcode Part I located at www.onlineaha.org and then attends the 1 hour skill verification on April 20th. Skill verification includes a megacode, Intraosseous needle placement & ambu bag management. The written exam is administered online and the participant prints the certificate of completion at the skill session. AHA PALS card awarded after skill component is completed.
